# WHEN TO PRUNE HOLLY

Holly pruning can be performed during two key periods:

- 1. During winter dormancy
- 2. Immediately after blooming, to preserve berry production (as hollies bloom on old wood)

Avoid late summer pruning to prevent encouraging tender shoot growth late in the season.

#### Meserve Hollies (China & Blue Prince/Princess)

These varieties rarely require extensive pruning for appearance. However, Blue Prince & Princess benefit from regular shaping while young. For mature plants, prune sparingly, focusing on tip-pruning.

# Japanese Hollies (Sky Pencil)

Minimal pruning is recommended. Only prune to control height or to address damage from snow or ice accumulation.

## **Inkberry Holly**

Prone to legginess, Inkberry Holly responds well to shearing, similar to boxwood maintenance.

## Winterberry Holly (Deciduous)

When necessary, remove up to one-third of the stems, prioritizing the oldest and thickest ones for removal.
